Reference Group mission and objectives

The Spotlight Civil Society Reference Group (CS-RG) is an institutional mechanism to harness civil society expertise to strengthen the Initiative's effectiveness and accountability to the women's movement. The CS-RG's mission is to advocate for and advise the Spotlight Initiative, informed by the women's movement, as partners for the realization of Spotlight's objectives.

Our core objectives for the period 2020-2021 are:

- 1) The CS-RG operates with a clear and shared understanding of its role, is adequately supported to undertake its work, and has a full mandate to both advise and participate in decision-making on Spotlight implementation at the global/regional/national level;
- Women's rights defenders and organisations (WRD/Os) at all levels especially those representing structurally-excluded women and girls – are fully informed about, and can meaningfully participate in decision-making on, Spotlight's implementation in their countries/regions;
- 3) WRD/Os at all levels have access to a mechanism for coordinated and solidarity advocacy with others (including, but not limited to, the CS-RG) regionally and globally; and
- 4) Implementation of the Spotlight Initiative is effectively monitored by WRD/Os at all levels (against shared indicators and criteria that they co-create), and resulting reports influence future implementation.

Assumptions underlying this Workplan

Achievement of the objectives laid out in this Workplan assumes that:

- 1) Reference groups at all levels are supported in terms of respect for their mandate and in operational resourcing (including budget) by relevant Spotlight structures;
- 2) Budget is provided to the CS-RG's workplan; and
- 3) Those CS-RG members leading/supporting work areas dedicate the time needed to progress the work, and other CS-RG members to provide input as needed.
